CAMP CHECK-IN

All Campers (overnight and day campers) check-in between 12p.m. – 1p.m. on July 12th at Keenan Hall. Day campers will enjoy dinner with the overnight campers and be picked up at 9 p.m. on first night.

CAMP ENDS

All campers (overnight and day campers) check-out after the conclusion of the camp tournament on July 15th. Parents are invited to watch the camp tournament and brief closing ceremony on the last day of camp before checking out at Keenan Hall.

The tournament will start at 10:30 a.m at Stinson Rugby Field, and will conclude at approximately 12:00 p.m.

DAY CAMPERS

Camp will run from 12:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. on July 12th & 13th and 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. on the 14th, and 10 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. on the 15th. Please make sure to arrive 10 minutes before camp each day. Pick-up and drop-off will take place at Stinson Rugby Field.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Camper bags may be inspected upon check in or at any time during camp to ensure no drugs, alcohol or other improper substances are brought to camp. Drugs, alcoholic beverages and cigarettes are strictly forbidden and constitute, along with general misconduct, grounds for immediate dismissal from camp without refund or credit.

SPENDING MONEY

We recommend that each overnight camper bring **\$50-\$60** per week of spending money to cover incidentals like snacks, souvenirs and activities.

HOUSING & ROOMMATES

- Overnight Campers will stay in Keenan Hall. Campers will be placed in double rooms with other campers their same age. Rooms are assigned by age and roommate requests. Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided in the Dining Hall on campus.
- If you have a **roommate request**, and have not already given it to us, please do so **no later than 48 hours before the start of camp**.
- If you don't have a roommate request, you will be placed in a room with someone near your age. It will be a great opportunity to meet someone new!
- Campers are under constant supervision as coaches/staff live with them while they are at camp.
- There is no A/C in the dorms. We recommend you bring a fan.
- **Linens ARE NOT provided.**

PROPERTY USE

You acknowledge and agree to assume and be fully responsible for any and all property or other damage to the room or any other facility used at the University of Notre Dame Rugby Camp.

CHECK LIST

All players need to wear rugby shorts/socks with their issued training jersey during practice). Camp jerseys will be washed nightly, but personal laundry can be done on own, in laundry facilities on campus if desired.
